

Dear Year 11 Students,

Exam Results Collection- Thursday, 20th August

Whilst this year has been very different from what we would have wanted for you, we are looking forward to you receiving your results in August. I would like to take this opportunity to extend our thanks to students and their families for the support offered throughout your time with us.

Year 11 will be able to collect GCSE exam results from school on Thursday, 20th August 2020. In order to maintain social distancing measures, please enter through the gate on Back Lane and we would then ask you to line up to enter the Ede Studio. To ensure safe collection, the following time slots have been allocated for students to collect results:

11E1 and 11W3	9.00 - 9.30am
11O2 and 11T3	10.00 - 10.30am
11O1, 11T1 and 11W1	11.00 – 11.30am
11E2, 11W2 and 11T2	12.00 – 12.30pm

Results will not be available beyond these time slots and we will only be able to permit the student collecting the results in order to maintain social distancing measures. On the day itself, we have arranged for staff to be available in the canteen to provide advice and guidance if you have not yet confirmed your pathway for next year.

There will be social distancing measures and hand sanitiser stations in place at Thomas Alleyne's. We regret that we will not be able to accommodate parents and families on this occasion and would ask you not to enter the school site or wait by entrances. Students should adhere to the safer travel guidance when travelling to and from school and, once results have been collected, leave immediately. If you or any member of your family display any symptoms of Covid-19, we would ask that you do not attend school.
