**Exam Results Collection- Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> August**

Whilst this year has been very different to what we would have wanted for you, we are looking forward to you receiving your results in August. I would like to take this opportunity to extend our thanks to our students and families for the support that you have offered to Thomas Alleyne's throughout your time with us.

Year 13 will be able to collect A level exam results from school on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> August 2020. In order to maintain social distancing measures, please enter through the gate on Back Lane and we would then ask you to line up to enter the Ede Studio. To ensure safe collection, the following time slots have been allocated for students to collect results:

13A and 13B	9.00 – 10.00am
13C and 13D	10.30- 11.30am

Results will not be available beyond these time slots. On the day itself, we have arranged for staff to be available in the canteen to provide advice and guidance with your pathways should it be required or if you are looking to confirm university places. If you are expecting any GCSE results, they can be collected on Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> August, between 12.30 – 1pm.

There will be social distancing measures and hand sanitiser stations in place at Thomas Alleyne's. We regret that we will not be able to accommodate parents and families on this occasion and would ask you not to enter the school site or wait by entrances. Students should adhere to the safer travel guidance when travelling to and from school and, once results have been collected, leave immediately. If you or any member of your family display any symptoms of Covid-19, we would ask that you do not attend school.
