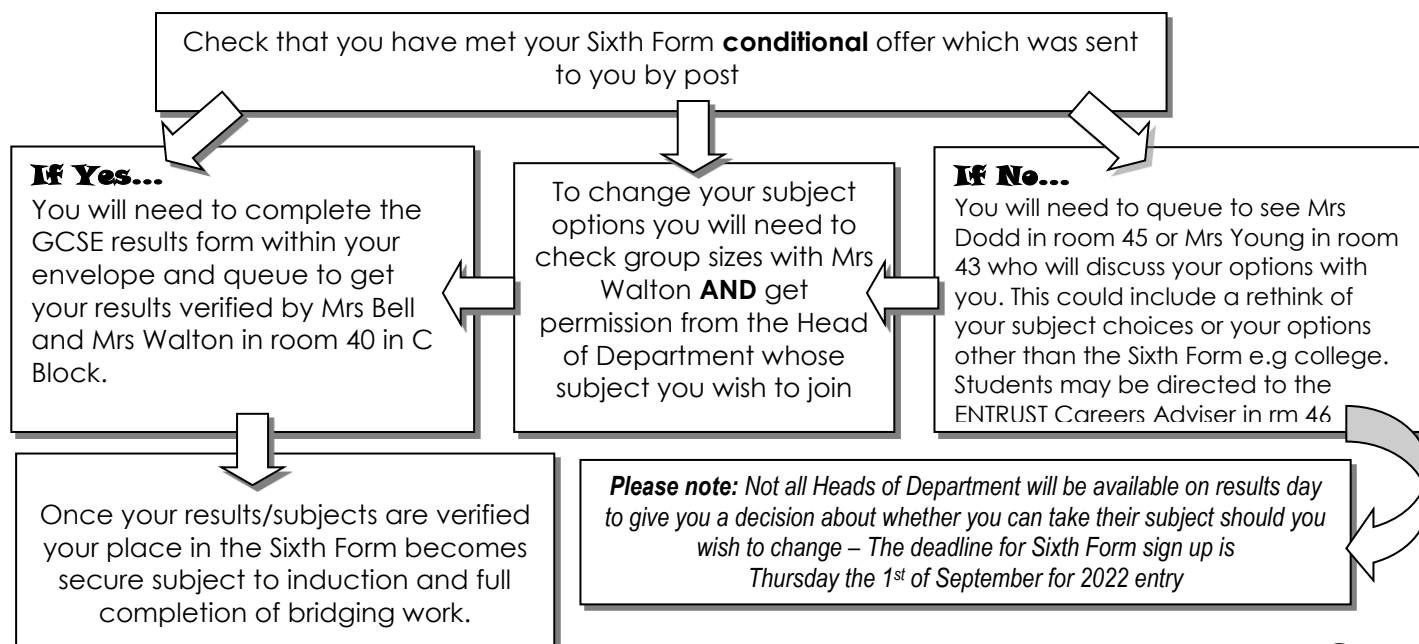




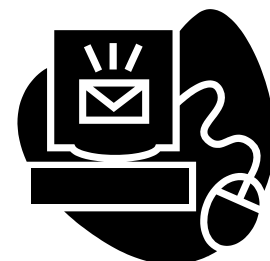
## Arrangements for joining the Sixth Form:

Year 11 Results Day 2022 is Thursday the 25th of August and your results will be available for collection from the school theatre between 9am and 12.00pm.

Once you have received your results you need to...



- If you are unable to make results day on the 25th of August you will be able to collect your results and sign up for the Sixth Form on Thursday the 1<sup>st</sup> September between 10.00am and 12.00pm in the Sixth Form area.

## Sixth Form Bridging Work:

## **Sixth Form Uniform:**

- Please ensure that you purchase the **correct** uniform items in preparation for starting the Sixth Form. We are introducing stricter sanctions for uniform infringements.
- For males the basic requirement is a trouser suit with a shirt and tie and smart shoes.
- For females the basic requirement is a skirt or trouser suit with a blouse style top and smart shoes. A dress suit may be worn but both items should be plain and match each other.
- Dark denim and un-matching items are **not** permitted.
- Please refer to your Sixth Form guide or the school website for a more comprehensive list,

## **Induction Period:**

- All new Year 12 students will start the Sixth Form on Tuesday the 6th of September and will embark on a one-day induction programme.
- During your induction day you will complete sessions aimed at helping you to adjust to life in the Sixth Form alongside clarifying our expectations of you.
- When you arrive on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> September a note of your designated form group will be up in the Sixth Form area. You will attend form at 8.40am where your tutor will give you a copy of your personal timetable.
- Your subject lessons will start on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> of September.
- Once you start lessons you will be placed on an induction monitoring period where you will have to meet certain criteria to maintain your place – this will be explained on the induction days. Failure to meet these expectations may result in you being asked to leave the Sixth Form.

## **Subject Changes:**

- You can change subjects with permission from the Head of Sixth Form and completion of the relevant documentation. You can only change subjects after you have completed one week and will only have one week in which to submit an application to change.
