What is Operation Encompass?

Operation Encompass is a national initiative that helps schools support children and young people who may have been affected by domestic abuse. It ensures that our safeguarding team is promptly informed by the police if a child has been present at, or impacted by, a domestic abuse incident.

Why is this important?

This information allows us to provide immediate, tailored support to pupils who may need it, ensuring their safety and wellbeing are always a priority.

What does this mean for you and your child?

- **Confidentiality:** Information shared with the school is treated in strict confidence and only key staff are informed.
- **Support:** We are here to listen and provide help to any pupil or family who needs it.
- **Partnership:** We work closely with parents, carers, and external agencies to keep our pupils safe.
